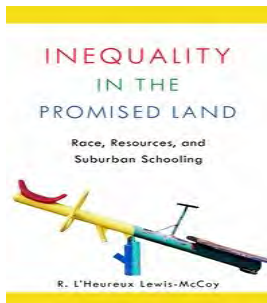


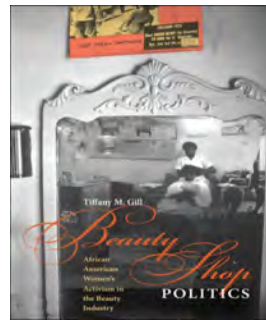
Alumni Publications

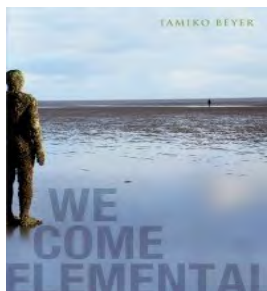

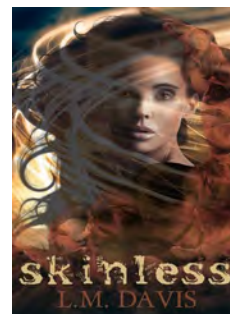
